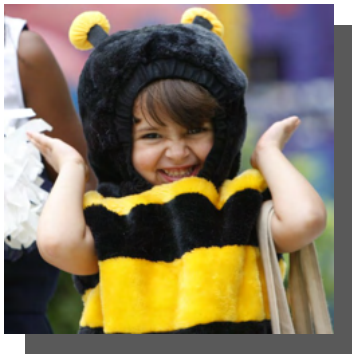
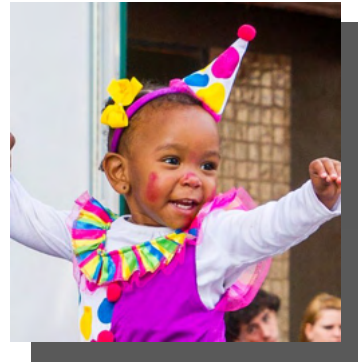
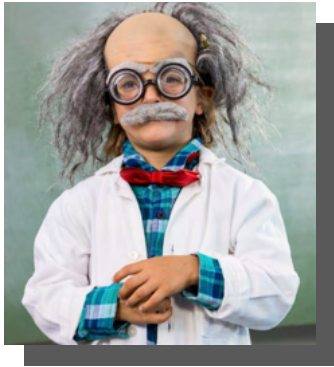

3. Entries must be delivered to event site from 4:30 PM until 5:00 PM on Saturday, October 30th (if needed an October 31st rain date may happen with registration still between 4:30 PM 5:30 PM - revised date will be announced on DCAC’s Facebook site.)
4. The enclosed Registration Form must be provided at the time of entry. Your pumpkin will be assigned an entry number at the time you register.
5. Winners will be announced at 7:30 PM at the Town Gazebo and you must be present to win. A check will be provided to each winner.

- 6.Entries must be submitted between 4:30 to 5:00 PM to be included in this contest. A rain date of October 31 may be used due to weather. Should this be necessary an announcement will be made on the Arts Council's Facebook site.
